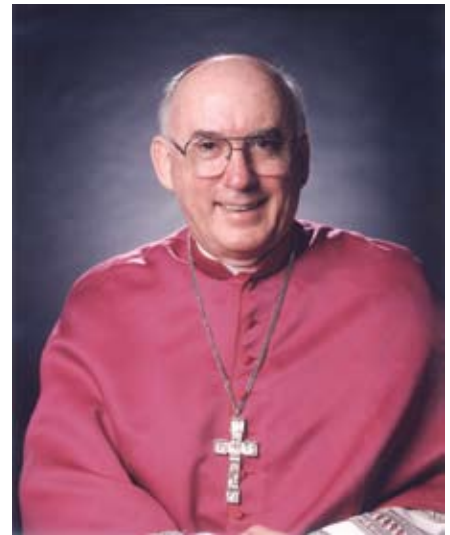


Lenten Reflection...
