6:35 - 7 p.m. Reflection

Fr. Bryan led a reflection on having an Eternal Perspective using the analogy of a long rope where our life on earth represents an inch worth of time compared to the multiple feet of rope that are eternity. We should live our lives with eternity in mind and help others to do the same.

7:00 - 7:40 p.m. Parish Priorities & Updates

- **Synod update:** Deanery representatives will attend the Synod on Pentecost.
- Lay Advisory Board update: The Archdiocese is planning a three-year Eucharistic revival with listening happening at all levels of our faith community (international, national, diocese, deanery). Other topics that have been covered in recent Deanery meetings are whether Catholic universities are teaching the catholic faith correctly. There are also discussions around options to have Mass in Latin. Finally, there was a presentation around the treatment of Native Americans at Catholic boarding schools and how the Church is asking for forgiveness and healing for the wrongs that took place in those settings.
- Evangelization Update: More households signed up to be visited than we had volunteers for. The council suggested that the communication of this initiative be expanded so that more parishioners could be aware of this and find ways to participate.
- Fellowship: We revisited the topic as a council to check on progress and how best for the council to either lead, support, consult, or otherwise support this effort. In general, the council wants to see more collaboration with the festival committees. The recent Triduum ministries were used as an example of great collaboration between the three parishes.
